our key agency highlights

We launched our 1st Annual Healthy Happy Holidays event series with over 3,000 people in attendance across five events: Costume Shop, Trunk-or-Treat, Share-the-Table, Toy Shop, and Winter Holiday Fair.

2023 also marked our **most successful annual campaign** in the last five years! Thanks to our supporters who rose up to help us in our hour of need.

We raised \$383,000 in capacity building grants that will lay the foundation to lift families out of poverty. Our funders included Destination Home, Santa Clara County Office of County Executive, Valley Medical Foundation, and the Winograd-Hutner Family Fund.



our impact

10,874 duplicated children, youth, adults, and seniors through our community day programming.

because no other organization listens to our needs and allows us to use our voice to advocate for our needs and guide changes in the program.

\$19,000 in scholarships was provided to 16 young adults.

My family is on limited income, but Sunday Friends' support helps ensure my continued attendance in college.

106,683 pounds of food & 16,958 basic needs items were provided to families, and \$110,000 raised in Tiendita de Apoyo merchandise.

We earn through Sunday Friends, I am able to, instead, spend on other items we need in the household. I am also able to save a little and have money available in case the need arises.

5640 individuals participated in 145 live workshops and classes.

This year, my favorite classes have been the yoga classes! I've always been interested in yoga, but I've been unable to find a Spanish-speaking instructor. Now, having participated with Sunday Friends, I feel more comfortable finding instructional videos online and practicing on my own.


